Player Code of Conduct

The Capital Summer Badminton Club (CSBC) will operate within a positive atmosphere of respect, fair play and good sportsmanship. Regular organized club challenge games/competitions will be offered along with board selection play to permit challenging games at appropriate levels for all members and guests, at the same time as providing an opportunity for social play among all members and guests.

Respect the court time allowed for games. Leave your court promptly for rotation.

Zero tolerance for loud, abusive or profane language.

Zero tolerance for racquet throwing or indiscriminately hitting the shuttle.

Share your expertise with less experienced players and to encourage varieties of game play, we limit a maximum of two games among the same group of four players if there are players waiting on the side.

Keep a smile whether you win or lose, whether you are having a good day or not.

Develop a consistent habit of good sportsmanship and fair play,

- Keep the score correctly – state the score clearly after each rally.
- Call the lines fairly (remember it is the lines on your own side of the net for which you are responsible).
- Shake hands after each match.
- Congratulate your opponent politely if you lose.
- Acknowledge a strength, good shot, or good rally of your opponent when you win. Accept congratulations graciously from your opponent.

Proper badminton attire required – indoor non-marking court shoes, shorts, and t-shirts.

Chewing gums, candies, food and soft drinks, etc. are not allowed while on court.

Hats are not allowed while on court.

Protective glasses strongly recommended.

Have a great season of friendly, competitive play.
